


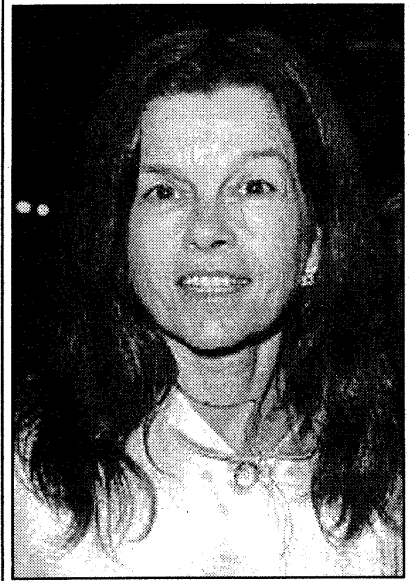

## 1st Queens International Film Fest Held In Forest Hills

A traditional ribbon cutting took place Friday, November 14, at noon at the Midway Theater, 108-22 Queens Blvd., Forest Hills, and marked the opening ceremony of the First Queens International Film Festival. Three days later—on Sunday, November 16—major stars, an awards ceremony, a performance by Nino Brown, dancing and dining provided a finale to the festival.

Following the screening of "Downtown," the closing night film, actors and other industry professionals presented awards for Best Short, Best Documentary, Young Filmmaker, Best Director, Best Producer, Best Feature Film, International Award and a Humanitarian Award.
